- Egg to be painted or inked.
- No decoration may be applied.
- Some type of upright support is recommended.
- Painted egg Must have been created by the exhibitor.

TRAILER HOOKUPS

Overnight parking is available at the fairgrounds. The rate is \$35.00 per night. Please include your reservation and fee with your entry form.

- Judging criteria-eggs to be uniform in shape, shell, texture, size, color and appearance.
- When a breed standard has stated a color, variation from this is penalized.
- Entries shall note the breed of eggs, mix breed or unknown.
- Non Standard includes mix or unknown ancestry
- All Other class is for any other eggs like Emu, Turkey, and Ostrich
- Egg Show Champion will be selected from the Main egg division only.

Sub Divisions

- Main egg competition groups of 3 eggs. - Open/Jr.
- Large Eggs Breed or non-standard noted on entry card.
 - Classes White, Brown, and All other colors (speckled or mottled entered by background color)
- Bantam Eggs - Breed or non-standard noted on entry card.
 - Classes White, Brown, and All other colors (speckled or mottled entered by background color)
- Waterfowl Eggs - Breed or non-standard noted on entry card
 - Classes White, Brown, and All other colors (speckled or mottled entered by background color)
- All Other Eggs If breed is known it can be noted. For all other eggs Emu, Turkey, etc.
 - Classes White, Brown, and All other colors (speckled or mottled entered by background color)
- An Egg Show Champion will be chosen from the top eggs in each class of the main egg competition.

Decorated Egg Division

- Each class will be placed 1st-3rd
- 1 egg per entry
- Classes are Open and Junior (5-7yrs, 8-11yrs, 12- 18yrs)
- Entry to be hard-boiled or blown
- Egg may be painted, as well as decorated.
- Outline of egg must be recognizable.
- Egg decoration must have been created by the exhibitor.

Painted Egg Division

- Each class will be placed 1st-3rd
- 1 egg per entry

- An entry form is provided with each show catalog. Entries submitted on a plain sheet of paper are acceptable when accompanied by the proper information and entry fees. Only one exhibitor number will be assigned per entry form. Use a separate entry sheet for each exhibitor. All birds must be identified by a numbered leg band conforming to the entry form.
- Entry fee is \$5.00 per bird and must accompany the entry form. Make checks payable to GCPF.
- The exhibition, in all respects will be under the control of the appointed board of directors and the Superintendent of the GCPF, who will be governed by the rules and regulations of the American Poultry Association.
- Birds showing evidence of disease or parasites will be removed from the showroom.
- Only standard bred poultry will be judged in accordance with the latest published Standards.
- All birds will be considered Large Fowl unless otherwise stated on the entry form.
- Entry form must state whether birds are: bearded or nonbearded, single comb or rose comb, when it applies.
- No persons other than judges and show officials shall be allowed to handle the exhibits without the consent of the owners. Any person interfering with the judges or judging shall have his/her entire entry disqualified.
- GCPF reserves the right to substitute or hire additional judges if the need arises.
- All premiums and awards for specialty clubs and individuals are accepted in good faith, however, GCPF will not be responsible for payments of awards if not received.
- ALL BIRDS ARE ENTERED AT THE OWNERS RISK.
- Entering birds shall constitute agreement with the rules and regulations set forth herewith.
- GCPF asks all exhibitors to provide cage dividers for their own birds when necessary.
- ***NOTE – There will be a \$1.00 fee added to all late entries**

entry. Each individual will be responsible for care and feeding of any sale birds. All sales are to be handled by the seller, GCPF assumes no responsibility. The overcrowding of sale cages will not be tolerated.

SHOWMANSHIP

Showmanship will be held on Saturday at 10:00 am. Awards will be given. Pre-Sign ups are \$3.00, Sign ups at the Show is \$8.00. GCPF cannot guarantee that a bird out for Showmanship will get judged in the breed show. Birds used for Showmanship do not have to be entered in the Breed Show.

Main Egg Competition Division

- One entry is a group of 3 eggs
- Open and Junior divisions will be placed 1st-3rd.

Starred wins are earned in classes of 100 or more in the following:

- Champions and Reserve Champions in the seven bantam divisions.
- Best and Reserve of Breed and Variety.
- Best Display when 7 or more bantam displays are shown
- Best and Reserve Display when 10 or more bantam displays are shown.
- Best and Reserve Trio when 30 or more trios are shown by 4 or more exhibitors.
- A single bird is eligible for only one award and can earn only one starred win.

SPECIAL MEET

ABA Ribbons to Champion and Reserve Champion Bantam Star Pins will be awarded in all classes of 100 or more \$1 Bantam Buck for Champion and Reserve for all seven bantam divisions where there are a minimum of 25 birds competing A free listing in the upcoming ABA Yearbook under Who's Who in Bantams.

All wins in Classes of 100 or more will be denoted with a star * and be retained in the ABA records to accumulate towards the Master Exhibitor, Master Breeder, and Lifetime Achievement awards.

Only ABA members are eligible to compete for the above awards. ABA dues are \$25.00 per year \$70.00 for three years. (\$40 per year and \$105 for three years outside of USA). New members receive a copy of the quarterly and the latest available copy of the Annual American Bantam Association Yearbook. Winners that are ABA members will be listed in the yearbook under Who's Who in Bantams.
